

The International Association for the Study of Popular Music-US Branch (IASPM-US) presents the Woody Guthrie Award each year to the most outstanding books on popular music. Two awards are given: one for the most outstanding book that is an author's first monograph, and one for the most outstanding book beyond an author's first monograph. Winners receive a monetary award and are announced each year at the IASPM-US Annual Conference.

IASPM-US requests your nominations for the most distinguished English-language monograph in popular music studies published during **2022**. Books may be nominated by any member in good standing of IASPM, by members of the prize committee, by their authors, or by publishers. Copyrights must state 2022.

The deadline for nominations is **October 13, 2023**. Nominations should be sent electronically to Victor Szabo and should include the author's name, book title, and publisher's information including ISBN. The society will announce the winners at the 2024 IASPM-US Annual Conference.
